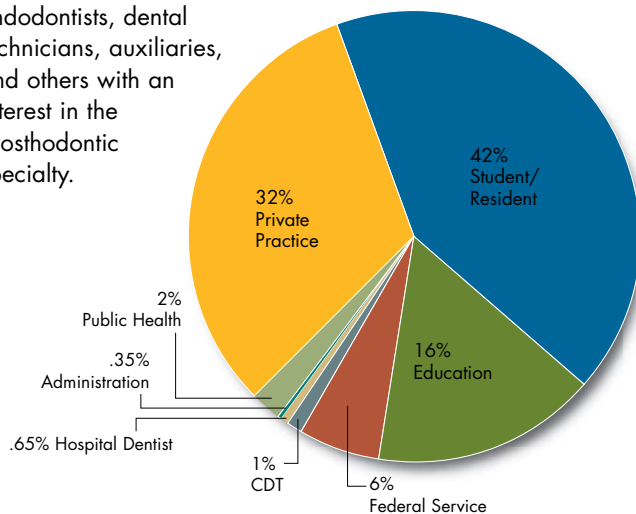
A vital part of the ACP Annual Session is the Exhibits where members and other attendees seek out the latest, most cutting-edge products and technology in the field.
