



## **Immediate Placement and Immediate Loading in Full Arch Restorations**

### **Course Overview**

#### **You will learn:**

This full day course will address converting the hopeless dentition into fixed provisional restorations in a single appointment 4 hour procedure. Clinical cases of immediate extraction, proper aveolectomy, implant placement and placement of a fixed-detachable temporary will be discussed. Advantages and disadvantages of this technique and proper case selection will be addressed also. Fabrication of the final fixed detachable once healing has occurred will be covered. Additionally, the incorporation of CT scanning into the prosthodontic practice will be discussed to include, installation, maintenance, and daily use of the technique in diagnosis and treatment planning of the prosthodontic patient.

#### **Objectives**

1. The attendee will have an understanding and working knowledge of how to use CT images in the everyday practice of prosthodontics to include the advantages and disadvantages of owning your own machine.
2. The attendee will understand the concept of immediate placement and loading of the full arch restoration. Also you will gain knowledge of the required aveoplasty to position teeth correctly in the prosthesis.
3. The attendee will have a working knowledge of clinical procedures, surgical coordination, prosthesis fabrication, post-op complications and success rates of the immediate load restoration.
4. The attendee will attain knowledge of completing the final restorations to include materials, occlusal schemes and framework design.

Dr. Paul Scruggs specializes in Implant Dentistry and Prosthetics. He received his undergraduate degree and dental degree from the University of Missouri at Kansas City in 1981. Dr. Scruggs completed his Prosthodontics training at the University of North Carolina School of Dentistry in 1986. He served in the U.S. Military starting with active duty US DENTAC in Ft. Bragg from 1981-1984, the US Army Reserve from 1984-1989, and the NC National Guard from 1998-2005. His duties ranged from general dental officer to acting commander of all medical/dental operations. Dr. Scruggs retired in July 2005 as Deputy State Medical Commander. He attained the rank of full Colonel (O-6). From 1986-2005, Dr. Scruggs also served as an Associate Professor at the UNC School of Dentistry.

Dr. Scruggs is a member of the American Dental Association, the American College of Prosthodontics and the Raleigh/Wake County Dental society. He also was the President and Past-President of the Academy of Southeastern Prosthodontists. Since 2005, Dr. Scruggs has lectured for Nobel Biocare, the world's largest dental implant company, on various topics in restorative and implant dentistry.
