Blending Tradition with Innovation: Digital Workflows in Complete Denture Prosthodontics

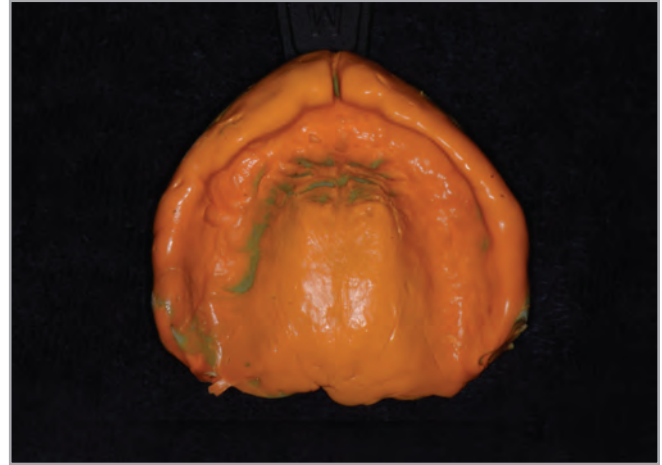
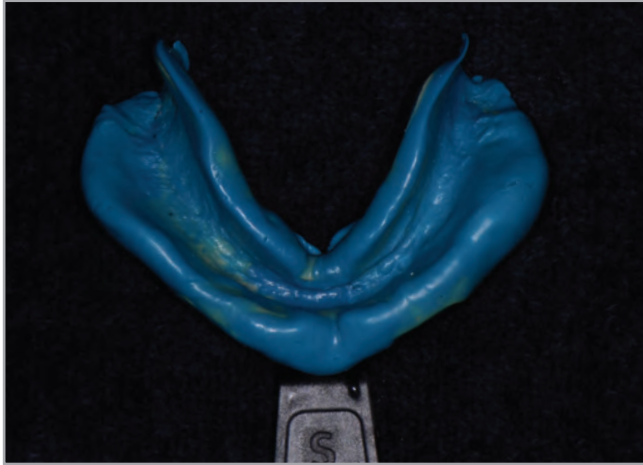
The art of denture fabrication is evolving, combining timeless principles of the maxillomandibular relationship with digital precision to create stunning, functional smiles with unprecedented efficiency.

Complete denture prosthodontics is the foundation for all aspects of dental reconstruction. The principles we use to create a functional dentition, one that a patient can eat, speak, and smile with, are carried through all aspects of restorative and surgical dentistry. Principally, the steps involved in the maxillomandibular relationship appointment are key to evaluating wax occlusion rims, an esthetic mockup, a natural dentition, and on and on. Having a thorough understanding of these steps allows experienced dentists to ‘see’ the final product of a case before committing to any irreversible procedures. It gives us pause-points in a complex series of appointments to check and double-check that we are progressing to the visualized goal. With the dramatic rise and incorporation of digital dentistry, our thorough understanding of the maxillomandibular relationship can now be harmonized with digital techniques to improve workflows, increase precision, and enhance the patient experience. In the following example, I will walk you through the process of a traditional complete denture case enhanced by digital technology and a thorough understanding of the principles of maxillomandibular relationship.

It usually takes five appointments to fabricate a set of complete dentures plus a few additional visits for post-insertion adjustments. With the use of thermoplastic impression trays and basic stick compound, we are able to obtain a precise final impression at the first visit just after

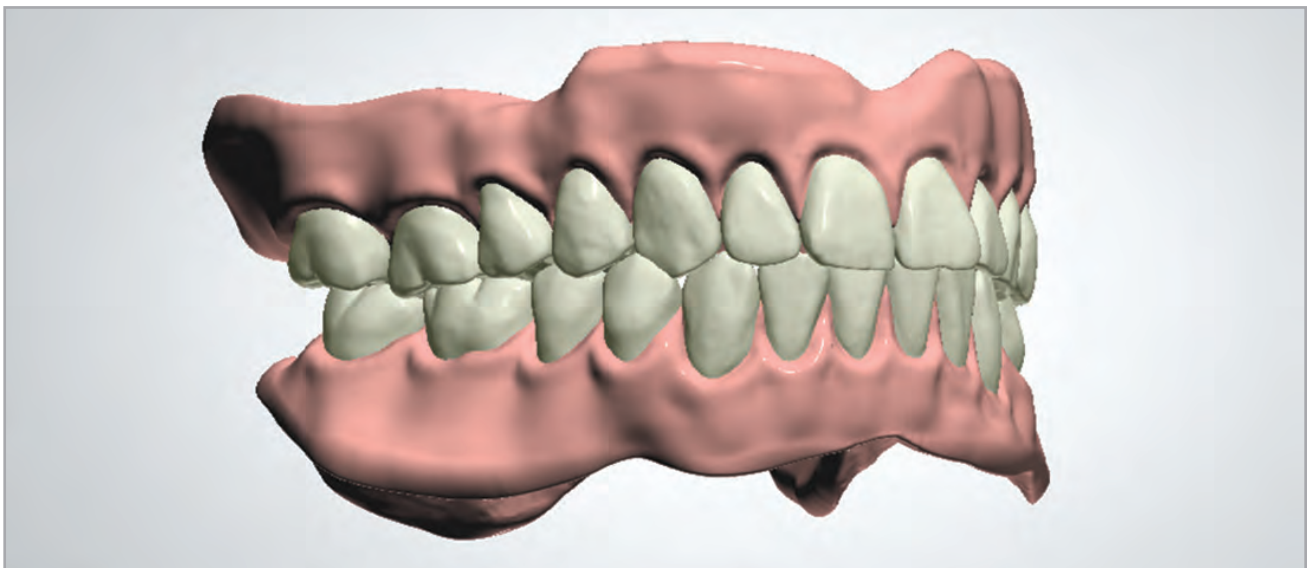
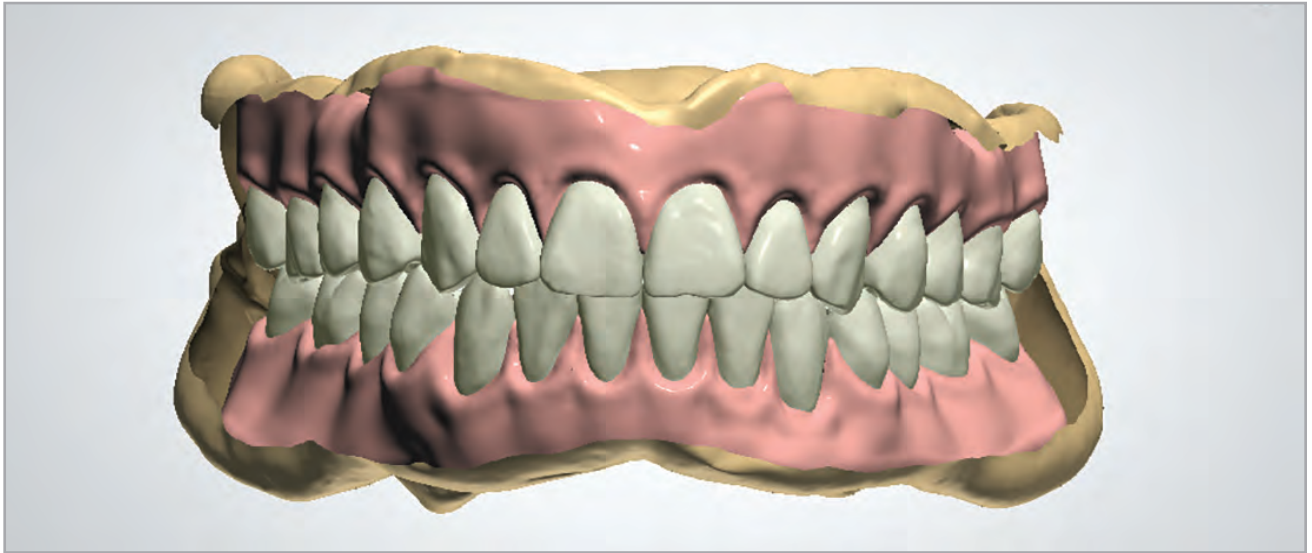
we've completed the clinical examination. In this workflow, we will make use of two additional components at this visit. The first is a papillometer reading. It measures the distance from the incisive papilla to the edge of the upper lip. This reading will allow us to digitally set teeth with the correct 'lip length' or 'incisal edge position,' improving esthetics and phonetics. The second component of this workflow involves a procedure that was originally introduced into complete denture prosthodontics by Phillip Pfaff in 1756. The technique recently came back into vogue with Ivoclar's digital denture technique utilizing the 'centric tray.' Originally called a "wax bite", it provides a preliminary registration of the residual ridges in the antero-postero, medio-lateral, and vertical planes. In our technique, we use a basic anterior triple tray and two thick globs of alginate. The patient practices a few times to establish a comfortable position, we can measure with dots on the nose and chin if needed, and the preliminary bite is obtained. At this point, we can scan both final impressions and the preliminary bite to generate STL files for digital design.

The laboratory step to create prototype dentures can be accomplished with any of a variety of software platforms used in-house or sent to your laboratory partners. In our workflow, 3Shape dental system was used to design the prototype dentures. Understanding the maxillomandibular relationship helps us follow anatomical guidelines to create

near-final prototypes with precision. It is important to note that the prototype denture is intended to be used as an estimate of the final denture. It can be added to or reduced, relined, and re-articulated. Additionally, one can add asymmetries, wear facets, and contours to make a truly natural-looking smile in the prototypes which are 3D printed or milled.

Visit two is a try-in where we assess the fit of the dentures first and make appropriate adjustments and then proceed—in order—to assess the various components of the maxillomandibular relationship. The maxillary prototype is inserted first. The lip length and lip support followed by the smile line, buccal corridors, and occlusal plane are

all assessed and modified as needed. The midline and occlusal plane should be carefully viewed from multiple angles and corrections made if needed. The mandibular prototype is inserted next and the occlusal vertical dimension is assessed using 6 factors: facial thirds, lip competence, overall esthetics, how the patient feels, interocclusal distance, and phonetics. At this point, a new centric relation record is captured. The most critical part of this visit is the wash impression of the prototype dentures. Although the prototypes fit well thanks to the scanned impressions and 3D printing, a low-viscosity PVS wash impression ensures even better accuracy by allowing the software to overlay the scans from both visits. Photos are taken, and a tooth shade and base shade are selected and the scans are sent back to the laboratory for final design and fabrication.

Although I typically design and print the prototype dentures myself, I find the final products are routinely exceptional when using a laboratory-milled denture base and teeth. This process combines the best mechanical properties and fit with outstanding esthetics that can easily be enhanced with surface characterization. Because the final dentures are based on prototypes

that the patient has already tested for fit, function, and appearance, the third visit is usually quick and easy, with little to no adjustments needed.

This streamlined denture process is only possible through a deep understanding of the maxillomandibular relationship, combined with modern digital tools and rapid prototyping. The practitioner is able to combine digital and conventional workflows in ways that enhance the patient experience and produce the highest quality results. Lastly, knowing the history of complete denture prosthodontics can be surprisingly useful—you never know when an old technique will make a comeback. ■

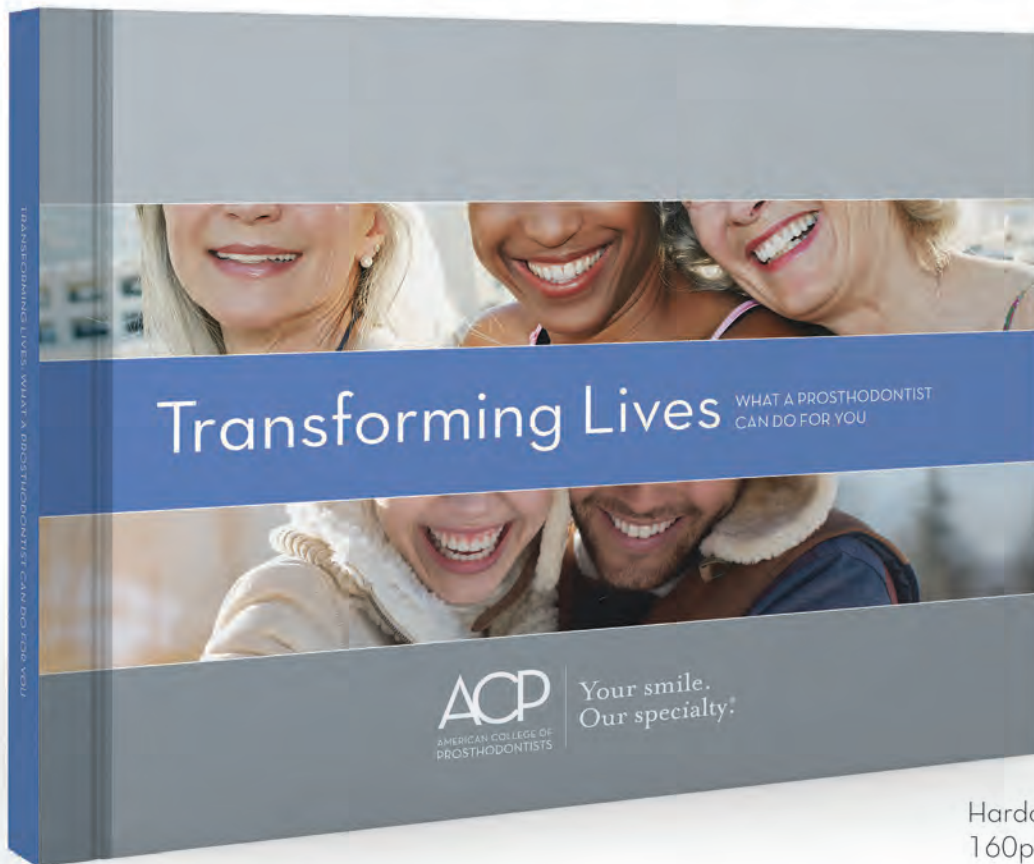

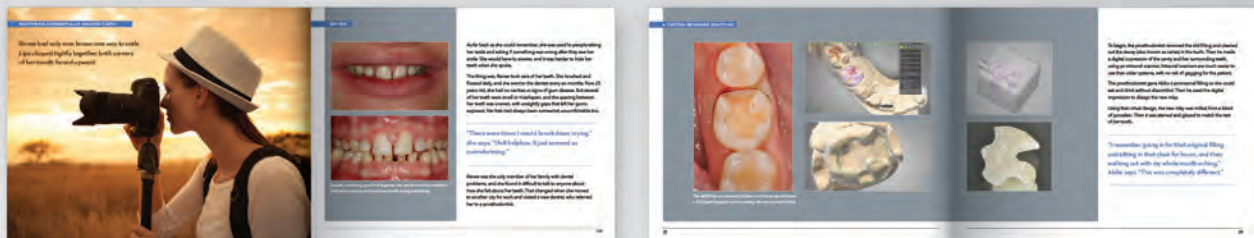

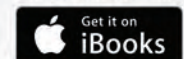

In the world of prosthodontics, it's not just about crafting perfect smiles—it's about resilience, precision, and balance.

Being a healthcare provider in 2024 is hard! Patients in modern society have leveled up. 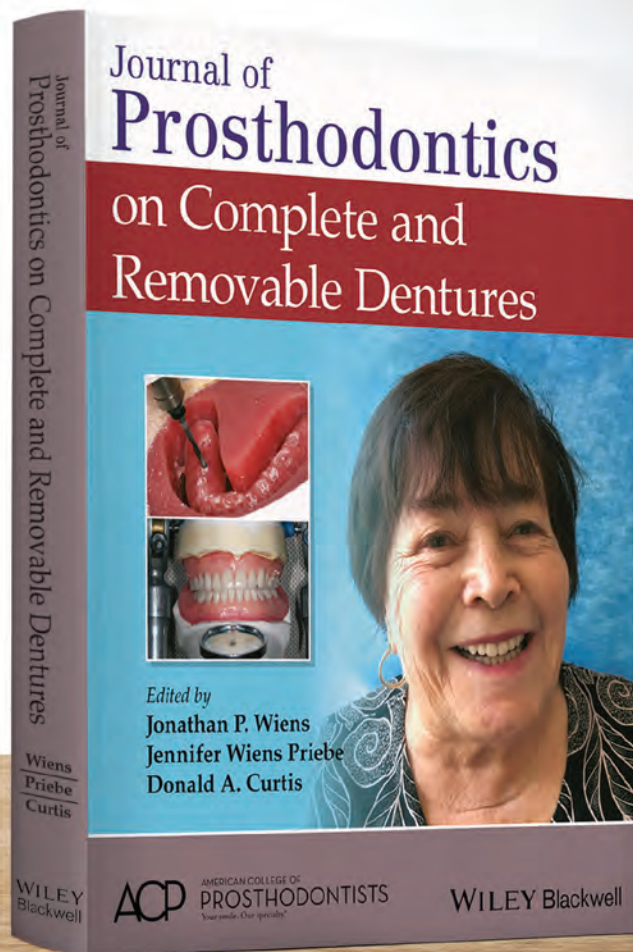
is something that most likely do not experience after their college years. It has truly been a BLAST to feel healthy and athletic and compete against others my age and experience level.

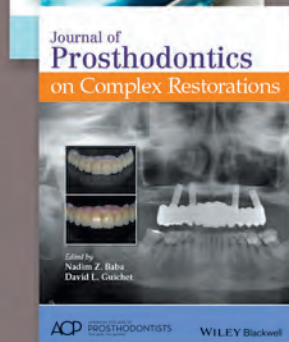
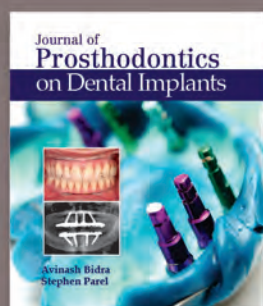

A final column from 2024 ACP President Dr. John Ball.

A successful team thrives when its members work individually and collectively toward a shared goal guided by a strategic plan. This has been my experience this year as President, leading a team composed of members, the Board of Directors (BOD), Central Office staff, and corporate partners. Everyone has made positive contributions with constructive ideas, using the current Strategic Plan for guidance.

Considering the five pillars of the current plan, here is an update on some of the activities.



Member Engagement

This year, membership initiatives have strengthened our community and engaged new audiences. Several predoctoral prosthodontic study groups are now active in dental schools, introducing students to our specialty and fostering early interest. Active membership remains comparable to 2023, with an encouraging increase in Life members. Efforts to enhance communication with all members have been a priority, particularly through social media outreach and targeted messages to recent program graduates and younger members. The Communications Division is crafting plans to further expand ACP's presence across electronic media platforms. To address evolving member needs, new committees have been established, focusing on areas such

as Board Preparation, Corporate Relations, VISION 5034, and Prosthodontic Program Directors Training. Regional Directors, guided by the Vice President, have made significant strides in developing their Sections and engaging members. The Immediate Past President has played a key role in overseeing the nomination process for ACP Awards and Recognition, ensuring that outstanding contributions within our specialty are celebrated.



Enhancing Quality of Care to Improve Patient Outcomes

Our commitment to improving patient outcomes is evident in the numerous quality initiatives implemented this year. The ACP Prosthodontic Webinars continue to be highly successful, providing members with valuable educational opportunities. Plans are well underway for the 2024 Digital Dentistry Symposium, which will be offered in a virtual format to reach a broader audience. Preparations for the 2025 Annual Session in New Orleans are progressing, promising another impactful gathering for our community. Additionally, the corporate-sponsored Digital Dentistry Curriculum is expanding, further integrating cutting-edge technologies into prosthodontic education. Looking ahead, we are developing a future ACP Research Symposium to provide a platform for innovation and discovery within our specialty.



Leadership Development

To support new Prosthodontic Program Directors, a specialized training initiative is being developed to address their unique challenges and needs. This year, we also hosted two Prosthodontic Educator meetings—one virtual and one during the Annual Session—providing opportunities for greater participation and engagement. These efforts reflect our commitment to nurturing current and future leaders within our community, creating a strong foundation for sustained excellence.



Positioning the Specialty as a Leader

Significant progress has been made in positioning prosthodontics as a leader within dentistry. The BOD is advancing VISION 5034, a transformative plan to achieve board certification for at least 50% of prosthodontists by 2034. The BRÅNEMARK collection, donated to the ACP, will be preserved and displayed at the National Dental Museum, ensuring its historical significance is recognized. Collaborative relationships with other professional organizations have been strengthened, including positive communications with the AAE, AAP, AAMP, the Academy of Oral-Facial Pain, the American Academy of Dental Sleep Medicine, and the newly established American Academy of Prosthetic Dentistry. The Board Preparation Course is being refined, with plans for additional webinars to enhance its value. Furthermore, ACP continues its active participation in the National Commission on Recognition of Dental Specialty and Certifying Boards, advocating for increased board certification to solidify the specialty's standing within the broader dental community.



Maintaining Organizational Sustainability and Viability

Organizational sustainability has been a key focus this year, ensuring ACP remains adaptable and resilient. The ACP successfully relocated its headquarters and implemented several operational improvements, enhancing efficiency and effectiveness. A “Go Green” initiative, transitioning ACP communications from print to electronic formats, is set to launch next year, reflecting our commitment to sustainability. Looking ahead, a new Strategic Plan will be developed in 2025, informed by data analysis from the current plan and insights gathered through upcoming surveys, including the Survey of Prosthodontists and the Member Needs Analysis. Financially, ACP remains strong, with adequate reserves ensuring stability. 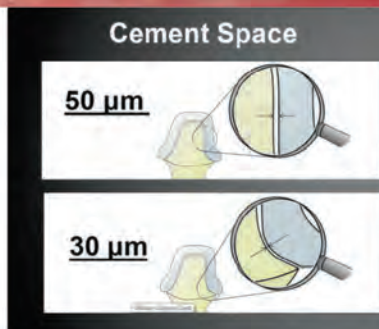
