This presentation will elaborate a thorough diagnostic sequence for comprehensive rehabilitation. Emphasis will be placed on diagnostic modalities that should be employed to create a customized treatment plan.

This course is designed to help the restorative dentist with evidence-based concepts of treatment plans that rely heavily on comprehensive diagnosis. A decision tree will be illustrated with objective analysis of esthetic and functional demands of the patient and the formulation of a rational plan would be discussed. Fundamentals of contemporary biological and technological factors that are used today will be reviewed.

Objectives:

- 1- To review current concepts in fixed implant supported restorations
- 2- Determine whether biology or technology should be used to improve esthetics, function and outcomes
- 3- Create algorithms for fixed implant restorations based on objective evaluations

He co-directs these courses in Las Vegas and at Rutgers, New Jersey. Dr. Iyer was inducted as a Fellow in the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons, Glasgow and has Fellowships in reputed organizations such as the Greater New York Academy of Prosthodontics and the Dental Facial Esthetics Academy. He is on the Editorial Board of the Journal of Oral Implantology and has published articles in several peer-reviewed journals. Dr. Iyer the Director of Smile USA Center for Reconstructive Dentistry and President of Smile USA Center for Educational Excellence. He is Past President of AAID and Chairman of the Global Committee of AAID. Dr. Iyer maintains a private practice in New Jersey.
