



Resident & Dental Student Poster Presentations – \$10,000



ADDITIONAL SPONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Co-Sponsorship of Dental Educators Meetings – \$50,000

Twice annually, once in April and once at the ACP Annual Session, the ACP Education Foundation hosts a one-day education summit for all pre- and post-doctoral dental educators.
