



Dan Gordon Award

...honors the lifetime achievement of individuals who have contributed at the highest level to the welfare and advancement of the College and/or specialty of prosthodontics, dentistry, science, and health professions.

President's Award

...honors individuals contributing outstanding vision and leadership for the welfare and advancement of the College and/or specialty of prosthodontics and contributions to the sciences or health professions.







Resident Scholarships - \$1,000 Each

Corporate Sponsored Symposia – \$25,000 Each (3 slots available)

The Corporate Sponsored Symposia offers you an opportunity to provide an exclusive continuing education program to ACP meeting attendees. ACP Spokespersons Network – \$40,000 Exclusive



Prosthodontic Review Course - \$5,000 (5 slots available)

To be hosted September 8-9, 2017, the ACP's popular two-day Prosthodontic Review Course is anticipated to have 100 attendees. 
