

This year, National Prosthodontics Awareness Week (NPAW) took place from April 21-27, 2024. Throughout NPAW, our committee organized a series of events and resources to engage with the public and dental colleagues, educating them about the importance of prosthodontic care.





The University of Iowa prosthodontic program celebrated NPAW by fabricating sets of dentures to veterans at no cost connecting their residents with the community.
