ACP Activities Summary: 2016 National Prosthodontics Awareness Week As of 5/23/17

Professional Presentations

<u>Arizona:</u> ACP Spokespersons Network member Dr. Douglas Benting lectured to 12 dental students from Arizona School of Dentistry and Oral Health (The Fake Club), demonstrating how prosthodontists can problem solve issues related to helping patients make decisions that are unique to their specific needs while creating a custom restorative treatment solution.

<u>California:</u> ACP Spokespersons Network member Dr. Don Curtis lectured to a group of about 200 UCSF dental alumni on the maintenance of dental implants to celebrate NPAW.

<u>Connecticut</u>: UConn School of Dental Medicine residents gave presentations on prosthodontics to staff and visitors of UConn Health about what prosthodontics is with brochures, dental models, posters, and before-and-after photos. These presentations took place during lunch hours Monday-Friday of NPAW and had 10-20 visitors per day.



Illinois: The pre-doctoral Prosthodontics Implant Club at the University of Illinois at Chicago held a session titled, "To Do or Not To Do- That is the Question! Factors to Consider for Successful Implant Restorations." This session supported and celebrated NPAW with speakers Dr. Jiyeon Kim and Dr. Foteini Touloumi. The presentation included an exclusive first look at UIC's new 3D projection and learning environment in the College of Dentistry.

Missouri: ACP Spokespersons Network member Dr. Marchack presented at the Midwest Dental Conference in Kansas City, MO in front of approximately 60 attendees including general dentists, prosthodontists, and dental students. His presentation was titled, "Esthetics and Contemporary Implant Prosthetics: Design Considerations for Superior Outcomes."

New York: Dr. Hyeongil Kim and Dr. Marshall Fagin hosted an evening program to promote prosthodontics as a specialty for the dental students at University of Buffalo School of Dental Medicine. 20 dental students were in attendance to learn about prosthodontics, hear case studies, and become informed about other prosthodontic programs at the college.



North Carolina: ACP Spokespersons Network member Dr. Karen Bruggers hosted a CE course featuring Dr. Ryan Cook with additional lectures by Dr. Mark Odom and Dr. Karen Bruggers. The lectures focused on anterior implant restoration and interdisciplinary treatment. Approximately 40 general dentists and specialists attended and NPAW/ACP decorated cookies were served.

<u>Ohio:</u> The 52nd Carl O. Boucher Prosthodontic conference was held on April 6-8 in Columbus, OH, drawing in prosthodontists, general dentists, residents, and hygienists from around the world.



Lunch and Learns

<u>Connecticut:</u> ACP Spokespersons Network member Dr. Avinash Bidra gave a 40 minute lecture to 55 predoctoral students of UConn SDM about contemporary prosthodontics and contemporary prosthodontists.

<u>Colorado:</u> Dr. Viensuong Nguyen hosted a lunch and learn about contemporary prosthodontics and prosthodontists at the University of Colorado School of Dental Medicine. Later that night, she held a study club to teach students prosthodontic tips and tricks. Overall, 60 students and faculty members attended the two events.



Colorado

<u>Ohio:</u> Dr. Damien Lee held a lunch and learn at The Ohio State University College of Dentistry celebrating NPAW, where the lecture hall was filled with students, faculty, and staff. Speakers included Dr. Ryan Mizumoto, Dr. Faris Jamjoom, and Dr. Geoffrey Johnston who spoke about immediate loading, digital planning, and 3D printing.

<u>Oregon:</u> The Oregon Health and Science University School of Dentistry celebrated NPAW by hosting a lunch and learn to raise awareness among its students about prosthodontics. Dr. Despoina Bompolaki, Dr. Jorge Garaicoa, and Dr. Amit Punj presented on the various aspects of prosthodontics specialty training including the curriculum, career options after graduation, and the application process. Short case presentations were also given so the 100+ attendees had the chance to see what type of patients are seen in a prosthodontic residency.



Texas: Dr. Bryan McLaughlin gave a one hour lecture at Fort Bliss on digital dentures, covering the development, relevant literature, different products available, and techniques involved with digital dentures. Approximately 20 dentists attended and learned about prosthodontics.

<u>Virginia:</u> Dr. Karen S. McAndrew hosted a lunch and learn bingo event at the Virginia Center for Prosthodontics where 23 people from the Richmond are attended.

<u>West Virginia</u>: The West Virginia section of the ACP sponsored an undergraduate dental education event titled, "As a Prosthodontist..." to celebrate NPAW. Students rotated through five educational sessions led by West Virginia University prosthodontists. Topics included maxillofacial, advanced treatment planning, scanning and designing CAD/CAM restorations, digital implant planning, and an introduction to the newly formed Prosthodontic Club at WVU.

Open Houses

<u>Alabama:</u> The University of Alabama at Birmingham held a Pre-doctoral Student Alliance NPAW event, resulting in a new ACP Pre-doctoral Student Alliance member. The student applied for membership upon attending the event and learning about the benefits of becoming a member.

<u>Connecticut</u>: UConn prosthodontic residents hosted an "Open Lab Night" during NPAW to show pre-doctoral students prosthodontic tricks in the dental lab. 30 students were in attendance and were able to learn a variety of skills and tricks prosthodontics use every day.



<u>Georgia</u>: The Graduate Prosthodontics Program at the Dental College of Georgia held a "meet and greet" event for the college's undergraduate dental students to learn about the prosthodontics profession. 45 prosthodontics residents, faculty, staff, and undergraduate dental students attended the event.

<u>Illinois:</u> The University of Illinois at Chicago College of Dentistry held a 1:1 Open Shop with the Advanced Prosthodontics

Program residents. 20+ pre-doctoral students signed up to shadow and learn more about the prosthodontics specialty.



Massachusetts: Harvard School of Dental Medicine held an open lab session and lecture for its predoctoral students to raise awareness and exposure of the prosthodontics profession. Dr. Gary Wetreich gave a lecture on "Prosthodontics Infinite Challenges" to the 45 attendees. Afterwards, pre-doctoral students explored ongoing cases from the AG Prosthodontic Program and shared their thoughts in prosthodontics.

<u>Pennsylvania:</u> Pi Dental Center in Fort Washington held an open house with the themes "Getting Your Spring Dental Cleaning" and "Springing into Action", where 40+ people were in attendance. Guests were

given tours, dental consultations, and received gift packages that included spring flower seeds. During NPAW, all patients and visitors were entered into a free raffle with prizes including gift cards for treatment at Pi Dental Center and a gift basket.

Pro Bono Care/ Oral Health and/or Cancer Screenings

<u>Canada:</u> Dr. Brian Kucey, Dr. Elena Hernandez-Kucey, and their team at South Edmonton Prosthodontics provided free oral cancer screenings during NPAW at an inner city clinic in Edmonton, Alberta.

<u>Massachusetts:</u> Dr. Mariano and Dr. Vergo of EMA Dental celebrated NPAW by offering complimentary prosthodontic consultations for new and existing patients during the month of April.

<u>New York:</u> ACP Spokespersons Network member Dr. Robert Rawdin and his office participated in the NYC Oral Cancer Awareness Walk at NYU Dental School with custom made t-shirts to spread awareness of NPAW.











2017 ACP YouTube Channel






