The meeting will be held in Baltimore, a city in central Maryland with undeniable charm and quirky neighborhoods. Baltimore is strategically located in the East Coast. It is only 40 minute drive from Washington DC and all DC has to offer. It is also only 2 hours drive from Philadelphia and 4 hours from New York City.

There is lots to do and visit in Baltimore:

- **Inner Harbor:** It is a hub for sightseeing and full of attractions. It features the National Aquarium with its giant turtles, sharks, dolphins, and electric eels. There is also the Maryland Science Center, Port Discovery, historic warships and Power Plant Live, a former power station that now houses restaurants, bars, and music venues. The Water Taxi offers a quick and safe way to get around the Baltimore Harbor.
- **Federal Hill:** A walkable neighborhood with great views of the Baltimore Harbor. It is known for its Cross Street Market, quirky storefronts, and the American Visionary Art Museum.
- **Canton:** A waterfront neighborhood full of bars and restaurants. It also houses Patterson Park and Canton Water Front Park.
- **Little Italy:** Home for numerous restaurants offering Homestyle Italian cuisine, bakeries and delis. Other attractions in Little Italy include the Star Spangled Banner Flag House, Reginald F. Lewis Museum of Maryland African American History & Culture, and the Baltimore Civil War Museum.
- **Harbor East:** A modern development in the vicinity of the Marriott Waterfront hotel surrounded by historic landmarks. It is a hub for shopping and fine dining with scenic views.
- **Dr. Samuel D. Harris National Museum of Dentistry:** See George Washington's teeth, the amazing teeth feats of circus performer Penny Wilson, watch vintage toothpaste commercials, and participate in hands-on exhibitions about healthy smiles. Make sure to call and make an appointment before visiting.
- **B & O Rail Road Museum:** A historic national landmark that offers a historic parade of trains, monumental buildings, and vast archive of locomotives artifacts where railroading comes alive every day.

Also in DC you will find the world class Smithsonian museums: National History Museum, the National Air and Space Museum, historic monuments and expansive park.
