**Eva Boldridge, DMD** is a prosthodontist and maxillofacial prosthodontist with additional training in dental oncology and head and neck defects.

Dr. Boldridge received her dental degree at the Medical University of South Carolina, where she was recognized with the ACP Undergraduate Achievement in Prosthodontics Award, the AAWD Eleanor Bushee Senior Woman Award, and the South Carolina Dental Association Outstanding Scholastic Accomplishments and Clinical Abilities Award. While in dental school she served as Vice President of the American Student Dental Association, as well as the founding president of the school's chapter of the American Association of Women Dentists. She subsequently completed her prosthodontics residency training at the University of Alabama at Birmingham and her maxillofacial prosthodontics/dental oncology fellowship at MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston.

Dr. Boldridge is currently serving on the Board of Directors of the American College of Prosthodontists as the Region 4 Membership Director. She is a member of the Greater Houston Dental Society, Texas Dental Association, American Dental Association, and the Houston Minority Dental Society. She has worked as Part Time Assistant Clinical Professor in the Advanced Education in General Dentistry Program in the Department of Restorative Dentistry at the UTHealth School of Dentistry (Houston). She is repeatedly recognized as one of Houstonia Magazine's Top Dentists.

Dr. Boldridge's practice includes full mouth rehabilitation, dental implants, dentures, partials, obturators, digital dentistry, palatal augmentation devices, mandibular resection dentures, and sleep apnea.
