

Captain Marvin Carmen, DDS Obituary

CARMEN--Captain Marvin, DDS, born September 10, 1919, died July 28, 2012. He was a graduate of Marquette University and served 43 years in the USN Dental Corps, from [World War II](#) through Vietnam, where he was Chief of Dental Service on the hospital ship Sanctuary. He retired from the Navy in 1981 and embarked on a second career as a Professor of Dentistry at [New York University](#), where he taught for over 25 years. He passed away peacefully at home surrounded by loved ones.

He is survived by wife Claire, two stepchildren, five grandchildren, and three great-grandchildren. The funeral is Monday, July 30, 2012 at 9:30 am at Riverside Memorial Chapel, New York City; interment to follow at New Montefiore Cemetery, Long Island.
