Po-Hsu Chen, DDS, MS, MPH, FACP is an Associate Professor and Interim Director of the Comprehensive Care Clinic in the Department of Restorative Sciences at the University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB) School of Dentistry, where he teaches across predoctoral and postdoctoral programs, from preclinical coursework to clinical supervision. He earned his DDS from Chung Shan Medical University in Taiwan in 2011, followed by a certificate in Prosthodontics from Boston University in 2018 and a certificate in Maxillofacial Prosthetics from UAB in 2020. He completed an MS in Dentistry in 2020 and an MPH in Epidemiology in 2021, both at UAB.

Dr. Chen is a Diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics and a Fellow of the Royal College of Dentists of Canada. He is also a Fellow of the American College of Prosthodontists and the American Academy of Maxillofacial

Prosthetics, where he serves on several national committees, including the ACP Predoctoral Education, Poster, and Research Committees.

His research focuses on prosthodontics, maxillofacial prosthetics, digital dentistry, dental materials, and public health dentistry. He has published widely in peer-reviewed journals and serves on the editorial board of the Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry, in addition to reviewing for multiple scientific publications.
