Digital Workflow and Your Practice

The expanding scope of digital dental technology enhances our capacity to realistically define treatment options and control outcomes. The use of volumetric radiologic imaging and integrated prosthodontic diagnostics in planning implant placement and restoration reinforces the communication among the patient and clinicians. Refined planning and execution of implant surgery encourages success. The further development of digital workflow in the creation of abutments and prostheses offers newfound ability to produce robust and esthetic restorations.
