Louis F. DeSantis, DDS, FACP received his DDS degree from the New York University College of Dentistry in 1984. He completed his post-doctoral residency from the Montefiore Medical Center in 1993. Dr. DeSantis has been in private practice and has served in academia since completion of his prosthodontic certification. Dr. DeSantis is a diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics and a Fellow of the American College of Prosthodontists. He is the former chief of Prosthodontics at the NY Methodist Hospital where he helped create the program. He presently serves as an adjunct associate clinical professor in the advanced education program in Prosthodontics at the New York University College of Dentistry. His duties at NYU include educating and encouraging post graduate prosthodontic students for the challenges of the ABP examination.

Dr. DeSantis has served on numerous boards in his local community and received citations for his work. These include recognition for service to the community from the American Red Cross following Hurricane Sandy, The Les Trautman Award for "outstanding contribution to the People of Staten Island", The American Legion Award on behalf of the United States Coast Guard for "Humanitarianism and Patriotism" and the lifetime achievement award from the Richmond County Dental Society.
