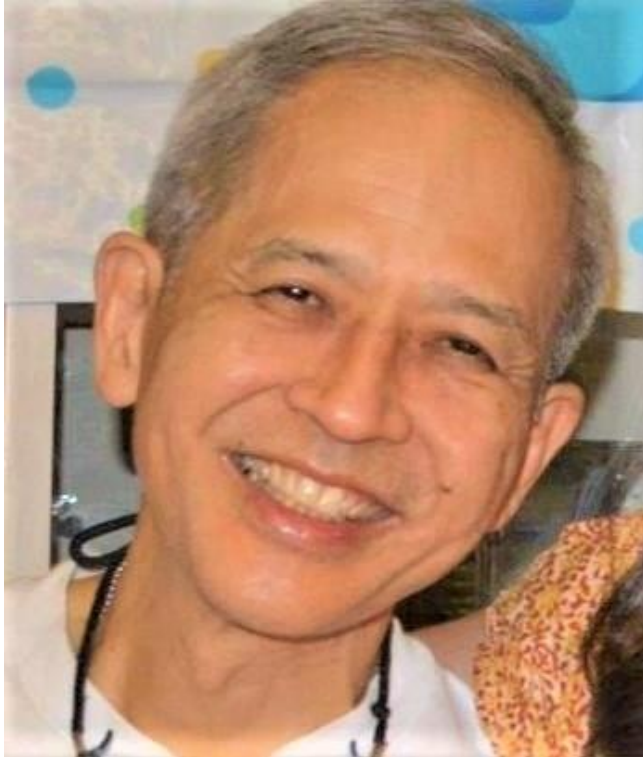


Dr. Alan F. Hamamura
