George E. Monasky, 75, of, Ambler PA, died on Tuesday, June 5th, 2012 born in Browndale, PA on July 18, 1936 to the late George and Minnie Monasky. He graduated from the University of Scranton and went on to the University of Pittsburgh, School of Dentistry graduating in 1960. Upon graduation he joined the United States Navy as a Dental Officer and was immediately stationed at Norfolk Navy Shipyard, Portsmouth, VA. He then transferred to Pearl Harbor, Hawaii where he served on his first of 4 ships, the USS Maury followed over his career by the USS Cadmus, USS Canopus and USS Holland. While stationed at Pearl Harbor he met and then married Army Capt Barbara L. Frahm, Nurse Corps on September 11, 1963.
