### *By the Governor of Alabama*

*WHEREAS*, approximately one hundred twenty million Americans are missing one or more teeth; and

*WHEREAS*, adults that are missing teeth or have failing teeth suffer from poor self-esteem, social embarrassment, premature aging, poor diet and loss of ability to eat, speak, laugh and talk appropriately; and

*WHEREAS*, Prosthodontics is a branch of dentistry that utilizes dental implants, digital dentistry, fixed partial bridges, fixed complete dentures, removable partial dentures and removable complete dentures to replace missing teeth; and

*WHEREAS*, Prosthodontists are recognized by the American Dental Association as dental specialists with three years advanced training, beyond dental school, in diagnosing, treatment planning, restoring and replacing the natural teeth to maintain or improve the function, comfort, appearance and health of patients; and

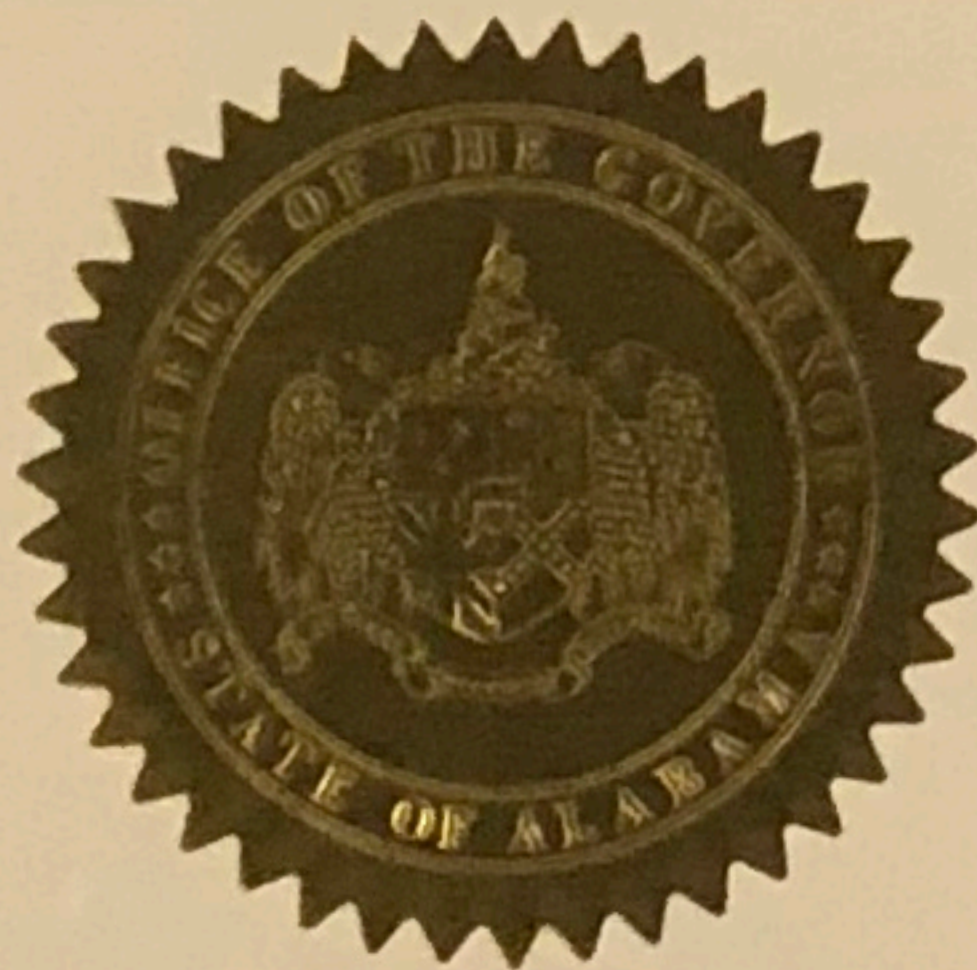
*WHEREAS*, Prosthodontists are experts in performing prosthodontics; and
