Thomas D. Taylor, DDS, MSD, FACP is professor and head, Department of Reconstructive Sciences and chairman of the Division of Prosthodontics at the University of Connecticut School of Dental Medicine. He completed dental school at the University of Iowa, a General Practice Residency at Walter Reed Army Medical Center, and a Prosthodontics and Maxillofacial Prosthetics residency at Mayo Clinic.

He is involved in both clinical and laboratory research and has published extensively in prosthodontic literature including the Journal of Prosthodontics. He is a past editor of the International Journal of Oral and Maxillofacial Implants and has contributed to over 20 books.

Dr. Taylor is past president of the American College of Prosthodontists and the American Board of Prosthodontics. He also served as Executive Director of the Board from 2001 until 2018. Dr. Taylor has been awarded the American College of Prosthodontists' President's Award (2003), the Dan Gordon Award for Lifetime Achievement (2007), Educator of the Year Award (2010), ACP Education Foundation Founders Society Award (2015), Distinguished Lecturer Award (2016), and Distinguished Service Award (2020).
